3 Gun Practical Shooting Challenge

Match to be held on the AGC 200yd High Power Range

DATE: 11/02/2013

TIME: 9:00am-4:00pm

Course of Fire: One or two man team - (280 point aggregate)

(Assistant Match Director for each participant)

- ◆ Firing will be conducted at various points at and forward of the firing line
- ◆ Each participant will engage each target firing from behind barriers w/limited exposure
- ◆ Each participant will engage a Double Tap Target and refrain from engaging the Hostage Target.
- ◆ All participants will follow all AGC & Match Range Rules

Range Rules: (1) All participants and spectators will wear eye & hearing protection at all times
(2) No person shall be in front of the participants, and teams must be side by side and move forward together. Teams may not proceed to next stage until all firearms are cleared safe.
(3) All gun handling will be done only at Cease Fire and at Firearm Safety Station with Firearm Safety Officer present.
(4) Match Director, Assistant Match Directors, Range Officer, Pit Director and Firearm Safety Officer will be in command at all times. Anyone who fails to follow their commands will be ordered to leave.
(5) Each participant will assist in the pits as described by the Course of Fire.
(6) Metal piercing, steel core or jacketed, incendiary, and/or tracer ammunition is prohibited. Steel and/or tungsten shot or slugs may not be used.
For shotgun ammo, the Match Director and/or Range Officer may restrict ammunition to certain minimum and/or maximum shot sizes or types for reasons of safety.
(7) Competitors carrying their handgun in a holster must have an empty magazine well, and the hammer or striker must be de-cocked. Anyone found in violation of this rule will be immediately escorted by a Range Officer to a suitable range or safety area where appropriate corrective action shall be made.
(8) When loading, reloading or unloading during a course of fire, the competitor's fingers must be visibly outside the trigger guard and the firearm must be pointed safely down range or in another safe direction authorized by a Range Officer

Fire Arms: Any rifle w/sling, smooth bore shotgun w/sling, pistol w/holster

Targets: Target Frames # 3,4,5,6 & 7 each w/Tombstone targets

(3 scoring rings worth 5,3,1 points)

Two Pit Attendants will score targets, pull target frames up and down as directed by the Pit Director and employ a double tap target or hostage target, limiting exposure of the targets
(Scoring on the hostage target is -5 point penalty)

Shot Gun Stage/Slugs will be stationary Tombstone targets

(3 scoring rings worth 5,3,1 points)

Pepper Poppers (5) will be shot on until all targets fall or a +5 second per target penalty will apply

Stage One: Firing from the 200yd line behind barrier with clear view of targets. With firing line *Hot*, each participant will bring his firearms to the line with actions open and ECI in place. On Command “**Make Ready**”, he will rack the shotgun, holster the handgun and stand ready with rifle.

On Command “**Are You Ready?**” Respond only if not ready: “**Not Ready**”

On Command “**Standby**” 1 to 4 seconds

On Command “**Stop**” Any Range Officer assigned to a stage may issue this command at any time during the course of fire. The competitor must immediately cease firing, stop moving and wait for further instructions from that Officer.

On Command Whistle (Start Timing)

- (1) Participant will load 8 rounds and engage each target offhand.
- (2) Reload 8 rounds and engage each target from a supported position optional
- (3) Clear firearm, actions open, (with magazines removed) will then move forward to Stage Two (with time still running). All movement forward is at walking pace.

Stage Two: Firing from 100yds behind a barrel barrier with clear view of targets. Participant will engage targets, firing 8 rounds. Reload firing 8 rounds. Clear firearm, actions open and rack rifle, then move forward to Stage Three (with time still running)

Stage Three: Shotgun w/slugs: Firing from 50yds behind a barrel barrier with clear view of targets. (3 scoring rings worth 5,3,1 points)
Participant will engage each Tombstone Stationary Targets firing 5 rounds. Reload with 5 rounds and repeat. Clear firearm, actions open and then move forward to Stage Four 25yds (with time still running)

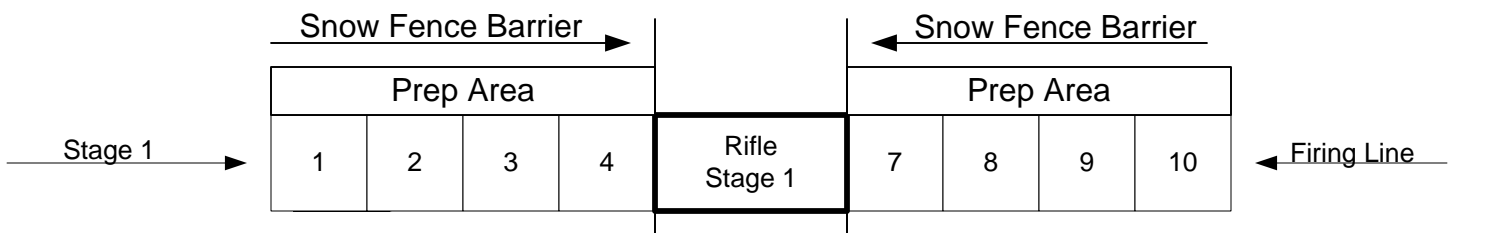
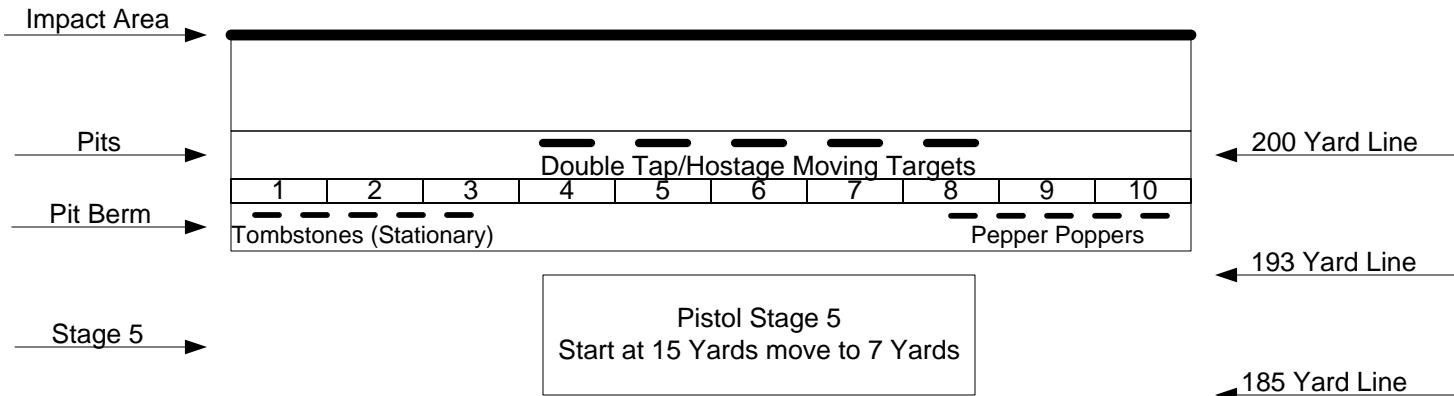
Stage Four: Shotgun w/ 00Buck Shot or smaller shot: from 25yds behind a barrel barrier Participant will engage Pepper Poppers firing 5 maximum rounds. Reload firing until all 5 Pepper Poppers are knocked down. (+5 second penalty per target for each target standing)
Clear firearm, actions open and rack shotgun and then move forward to Stage Five (with time still running)

Stage Five Handgun: Firing from 15yds with clear view of targets (no barriers)
Participant will engage Target frame # 3,4,5,6 & 7 each w/Tombstone target
(3 scoring rings worth 5,3,1 points) firing 7 rounds. Reload firing 7 rounds while moving forward 7yds at a walking pace.

At completion of Stage Five, time will stop. All firearms cleared, ECI in place and the Range Officer will declare “**Range is Clear**”. Participants will return to firing line collecting brass & firearms. Participants will then **Stand Down** until next Participant Team has finished before assisting in the pits. Match Director will open pits.

Pit Director will score the ten targets, log the time, and prepare for next participant/team. Results will be calculated as $\text{Score/Time} = \%$

Options: Due to ammunition scarcity, match may alter Shot Gun Stage to allow 30 Carbine and engage Balloons rather than Pepper Poppers.
